14th Annual National M.E.Ch.A. Conference Auraria Campus, Denver, CO. March 22-25, 2007

- 1 All participants in the 14th Annual 2007 National M.E.Ch.A. Conference must be sponsored by a recognized M.E.Ch.A. chapter. All chapters that are not recognized must be sponsored by their nearest recognized M.E.Ch.A. voting chapter. Recognized M.E.Ch.A. chapters are those that have voting rights in their respective region.
- 2 In accordance with Auraria Campus policy, we do not allow alcohol, drugs, or weapons to be brought to any National M.E.Ch.A. functions.
- 3 We realize that the use of alcohol and drugs outside of conference activities is the responsibility of each individual and their pertaining chapter. However M.E.Ch.A. de Coloraztlan asks that you maintain respect for our community and others.
- 4 In order to maintain an appropriate level of respect for each other, no racist, sexist, homophobic, or any other oppressive remarks and or actions. We will ask you leave and change if there is an issue with any gang related clothing/apparel. The aforementioned will be not tolerated throughout the conference.
- 5 For security purposes, we ask that all participants (i.e. MEChistAs, vendors, presenters, organizers, all other sponsored participants) wear their official conference registration name tags at all times. In the event that you lose your nametag, please report to the t-shirt table in the Vendor area immediately. Your name tag must be presented to obtain breakfasts, lunches and at the banquet dinner.
- 6 All literature must be approved by the hosting campus. No one will be allowed to physically distribute un-approved literature. Violators will be asked to leave the premises of the conference.
- 7 No Greek letters, national flags, or anti-M.E.Ch.A. paraphernalia will be allowed in any of the conference events.
- 8 We ask that you keep all conference rooms, facilities, and entertainment areas as you found them. Please be respectful of all buildings and property of the Auraria Campus. Please follow all rules established by each building, fellow MEChistAs, workshop presenters, and caucus facilitators.
- 9 The use of video equipment and/or recording devices will not be permitted. Hand held cameras must be registered upon arrival at the registration table. **NOTE: No picture taking/video recording is permitted during the mandatory meeting, caucuses, and resolution circle.**
- 10 M.E.Ch.A. chapters will ultimately be held accountable for their respective members and/or sponsored participants in compliance with the Principles of Unity.

M.E.Ch.A. de Auraria reserves the right to ask individuals and/or M.E.Ch.A. chapters who do not comply with any these principles to leave the National M.E.Ch.A. Conference without refund of registration fees.
